PERFORMANCES:—

- 1949—**GUERNSEY**, being first bird to loft in the **National Flying Club Young Bird National**.
- 1951—**NANTES**, being first bird to loft. **National Race**.
PAU. Again first bird to loft, National Race, 522 miles, velocity 895, being **5th. Section B. 32nd. Open**, with 1684 Birds competing, winning £79.
- 1952—**AMSTERDAM** with British Berlin Club, 352 miles, **2nd S.W. Section**, winning £10.
PAU. Again first bird to loft, National Race, 522 miles, velocity 685, being **4th. Section B. 50th. Open**, with 1711 birds competing, winning £122.

This grand Racer whose performances are more remarkable when it is realised that the above five Races are the only Races she has competed in and in each case although flying to one of the most westerly Lofts in the Country has had to contend in every Race with a West wind.

PEDIGREE:—

SIRE. BLOOD RED COCK NUHW.47.A.7844. Bred in these lofts. This Cock was never raced but kept for stock.

Sire. Blood Red Cock 300. Bred by the late Geo. Cloke from Red Chequer Cock 176, flown **NANTES**, and Red Cheq. Hen 156, a winner at 400 miles.

176 was a Son of Mons. Gurnays famous **BON RAYE** winner of 8 prizes in 9 Races.

156 was the daughter of **BON RAYE** who has produced many winners both on the road and in the Pen.

Dam of 7844. Dark Chequer Hen 712 bred in these lofts from 2022 and 2881.

2022. An own son of **CHAMPION 39** when paired to 228 a grand-daughter of the famous **YOUNG HAWK**.

2881. A daughter of **CHAMPION 39**.

DAM. BLUE CHEQUER HEN NUHW.46.J.1201. Bred in these lofts and kept for stock on account of her outstanding qualities as a Stock Hen.

Sire. **Bronze Cock RP.41.WDF.10**, a Son of **YOUNG HAWK**.

YOUNG HAWK. Bred and Raced by the late O. I. Wood. The Sire of Young Hawk was bred from a Son of Mons. Gurnay's famous **ANGOULEME** when mated to the daughter of the **OLD BLUE HEN** whose descendants won £45,000 for M. Gurnay in seven years.

The Dam of Young Hawk was a grand-daughter of **PETIT ECAILLE VIERZON** on one side, and a great grand-daughter of **ANGOULEME** on the sire's side.

YOUNG HAWK won 19 first, second and third prizes from 1924 to 1928 including 1st in the £1 pools 17 times. A grand Racer and superb producer.

Dam of 1201. **Blue Cheq. Hen RP.38.NW.133** whose Sire was a grand-son of **YOUNG HAWK** and whose Dam was a daughter of **YOUNG HAWK**.

1201 is therefore in-bred to this famous Racer **YOUNG HAWK** whose
