Dam of 7844. Dark Chequer Hen 712 bred in these lofts from 2022 and 2881.

2022. An own son of CHAMPION 39 when paired to 228 a grand-daughter of the famous YOUNG HAWK.

2881. A daughter of CHAMPION 39.

DAM. BLUE CHEQUER HEN NUHW.46.J.1201. Bred in these lofts and kept for stock on account of her outstanding qualities as a Stock Hen.

Sire. Bronze Cock RP.41.WDF.10, a Son of YOUNG HAWK.

YOUNG HAWK. Bred and Raced by the late O. I. Wood. The Sire of YoungHawk was bred from a Son of Mons. Gurnay's famous ANGOULEME when mated to the daughter of the OLD BLUE HEN whose descendants won £45,000 for M. Gurnay in seven years.

The Dam of Young Hawk was a grand-daughter of PETIT ECAILLE VIERZON on one side, and a great grand-daughter of ANGOULEME on the sire's side.

YOUNG HAWK won 19 first, second and third prizes from 1924 to 1928 including 1st in the £1 pools 17 times. A grand Racer and superb producer.
